Squamish, B.C. – Four local non profits and charities have been chosen as beneficiaries by the Squamish business winners of **Light Up Squamish: Window Wars**

The Squamish Chamber of Commerce, Tourism Squamish and the Downtown Squamish Business Improvement Association have joined forces again to support the Squamish business community. Recognizing the importance of local businesses to the Squamish community, Squamish’s three non-profit business organizations have been working more closely than ever to support our local businesses.

Throughout the month of December 2021, Squamish businesses were challenged to **Light Up Squamish** and bring some holiday cheer to the community with holiday displays. Locals headed out to see the displays, enjoy the festive spirit and vote for their favourite display. Hundreds of votes were made, with each vote providing a chance to win one of dozens of \$50 gift cards from participating businesses (purchased by the partners). The businesses with the most votes then choose their favourite local cause for a donation of \$1,000 to be made in their name.

Light Up Squamish: Window Wars aimed to increase footfall, bringing people to retail areas, creating additional exposure for businesses and some festive cheer. The partners added some extra festive spirit with holidays lights at the Squamish Adventure Centre, downtown Squamish, the Sea to Sky Business Park, Tantalus Road and the Squamish Town Hub. **Light Up Squamish** was funded by the BC Chamber of Commerce and the Government of Canada, with prizing contributions from the partners. Originally three winners were anticipated. Fortis BC generously stepped in with additional funding to support a fourth winner.

For every \$100 spent in a local business, \$63 is reinvested back into the community. This compares to \$14 from multinationals. That's because the owners live here, they hire your neighbours, use local suppliers and support local charities and groups.

The three partners – Tourism Squamish, Squamish Chamber and Downtown Squamish BIA – collectively represent hundreds of local businesses and have been working together to support local businesses.
